The role also includes attendance at competitions identified by the Head Coach.

Working as part of City of Swansea Aquatics Swimming Club, you will be responsible for the delivery of swimming coaching to the Competitive Development Squad.

Principal Responsibilities :

- To be responsible for the effective coaching, improvement of swimmer technique and development of swimmer skills and performance.
- To support swimmers at all stages of their development and provide support at competitions.
- Expected to manage and coach the Competitive Development Squad in line with the Swim Wales Child Safeguarding Policy endorsed by City of Swansea Aquatics Swimming Club and the City of Swansea Aquatics Swimming Club Code of Conduct for Swimmers, Staff and Parents.
- To ensure health and safety of swimmers is a priority at all sessions.
- Attend competitions designated by the Head Coach.
- To ensure professional conduct at all times with particular reference to punctuality, dress, organisation and communication skills.

Administrative Roles :

- Complete and record attendance through Swim Manager.
- Maintain accurate coaching records.
- Support parents and swimmers in regards to upcoming competitions and advise on entries.
- Report directly to the Head Coach and City of Swansea Aquatics Executive Committee and complete necessary forms or procedures for any matters concerning personal leave, absence or illness.
- Report any welfare or behavioural issues immediately to the Head Coach, Welfare Officer and Executive Committee.

General :

- The successful candidate will be expected to complete a Team Manager course and may be called upon to act as a Team Manager as required.
- The successful candidate will be expected to complete a Time Keepers course and may be called upon to act as a Time Keeper at any home meets.
