AGE AS AT:	22 nd September 2019
EVENTS:	All events will be Heat Declared Winner 25m Free, Back, Breast, Fly – 7U, 8U & Academy Bronze/Silver 100 IM – 7U, 8U & Academy Bronze/Silver 50m Free, Back, Breast, Fly – All ages 100m Free, Back, Breast, Fly – 9yrs+ only 200m Free, Back, Breast, Fly, IM – 9yrs+ only 400m Free – 11yrs+ only 400m IM – 11yrs+ only All entries are subject to confirmation from coaching staff.
AWARDS:	Awards will be given to the first three places in each age group. Awards will be presented at the City of Swansea Swimming Club Presentation Evening.
ENTRIES:	Entries must be received no later than the closing date of Sunday 1 st September 2019.
ENTRY PRICING:	£4.00 per event
CLOSING DATE:	Sunday 1st September 2019 (late entries will not be accepted).
SEEDING:	All events will be seeded and spearheaded, and will be swum slow to fast based on entry times. Entry times will be taken from the club database for seeding. If no time is held on the database, then swimmers will be entered with a 'no time'
SESSION TIMES:	Session times will be finalised when all entries have been processed and swimmers will be notified accordingly.
MARSHALLING:	It is the swimmer's responsibility to present themselves, ready to swim, to the marshalling area/personnel prior to the start of their event.
STARTS:	Over the top starts will be used wherever possible
ELECTRONICS:	Omega electronic timing system with electronic display
MEET RESULTS:	The meet results will be posted on the Swansea Aquatics website (www.swansea-aquatics.co.uk) within 72 hours of the meet closing. Results will also be passed to Swim Wales and ASA for their reference and inclusion in rankings.

WITHDRAWALS	No refund of entries will be made for withdrawals from the meet unless the withdrawal is due to medical grounds.
CAR PARKING:	Free car parking places are provided at Penlan Leisure Centre on a first come first served basis.
SPECTATORS:	£4 per day (under 12 years free) There will be no paper programs given out during Club Champs. When athlete entries and session times have been finalised you will receive a program via email.
DATA PROTECTION:	<p>Submission of entries implies consent to the holding of any personal data collected and used by City of Swansea Aquatics Swimming Club in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 and General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) May 2018.</p> <p>These details may be made public before, during and after the Meet. All data will be recorded privately, securely stored and disposed of when no longer needed. You have the right to view your personal data and request its deletion under GDPR.</p>
SWIM SHOP:	A swim shop will be in operation throughout the meet.
CAMERA USE:	<p>Mobile phones that have a camera facility /hardware are recognised as a camera or photographic device. Any photos taken should fall within the Swim Wales guidelines which are contained in the General Meet Conditions under 'Events' at www.swimwales.org/key-documents</p> <p>The publishing of a photograph of a swimmer under 18 years, either on a noticeboard or in a published article or video recording (including live streaming) of the meet must only be done with parental consent and in line with Swim Wales guidelines.</p> <p>The use of all photographic equipment is controlled at this meet.</p> <p>No FLASH photography is permitted.</p>
GENERAL:	The meet organizer reserves the right to make any alterations to these conditions if necessary and all participants will be notified. Any matter not covered by these conditions or by Swim Wales and FINA laws or technical rules will be at the club's discretion. The referee's decision will be final.
APPEALS:	Any appeals must be submitted in accordance with FINA procedures and will be handled appropriately.

Health and Safety Conditions for the Meet

- 1** The health, safety and wellbeing of all swimmers, officials, volunteers, spectators and visitors is paramount – all Health and Safety rules, regulations and requirements must be complied with at all times.
- 2** A full risk assessment will have been carried out in accordance with the Swim Wales Meet License conditions.
- 3** A copy of the Pool Operating Procedures and/or the Normal Operating Procedures and Emergency Action Plan for the facility being hired for a meet will have been obtained in advance, and be available throughout the duration of the Meet. All swimmers, officials, volunteers, spectators, and visitors are required, at all times, to abide by the rules set out in the Pool Operating Procedures and / or the Normal Operating Procedures and the Emergency Action Plan for the facility hired for the Meet.
- 4** Unacceptable Behaviour. Behaviour becomes “unacceptable” when it is considered “offensive” to others. This includes, but is not limited to, the following: theft, willful damage to property and / or equipment, acts of vandalism, abuse of alcohol and/or drugs, bullying, offensive language, aggressive /violent acts, threatening behavior, all breaches of safety practices, failure to comply with instructions / directions, actions that bring the sport of swimming into disrepute.
- 5** Competitive Start Award. Swimmers must have attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award in order to start from the blocks; (this is the responsibility of the club coach). Swimmers who have not attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award must lower themselves into over the side into the water, on the long whistle of the Referee before starting at an appropriate place.
- 6** Jewellery. For safety and security reasons, the wearing of jewellery is not permitted while in the water during warm-ups / swim-downs and / or competition. This includes watches, necklaces, chains, bangles, wrist bands, ear-rings (except studs), and rings (except wedding bands). Swansea Aquatics will not be responsible for any jewellery brought to events and will not be liable if such jewellery is lost or damaged.

City of Swansea Aquatics will not be held responsible for any jewellery brought to the event and will not be liable if such jewellery is lost or damaged.
