COVID EVENT PROTOCOLS

All persons attending the event must ensure compliance with any covid protocols and other guidance in place at the time of the event. The health, safety and well-being of all swimmers, officials, volunteers, spectators, and visitors is important - all Health and Safety regulations/requirements must be complied with at all times. It is the responsibility of the individuals attending to ensure that they have seen any such guidance.

Event Delivery Protocols:

1. Lateral Flow Testing (LFTs)

It is recommended that you carry out a lateral flow test prior to your arrival at the competition. If you are displaying any covid symptoms or are unwell please do not attend.

2. Face Covering

From 28th February, it is not a legal requirement in Wales to wear a face covering in certain settings. Individuals are welcome to continue wearing face coverings if they need to or feel more comfortable in doing so and we encourage everyone to be respectful of this choice.

3. Social Distancing

While it is not a legal requirement in Wales at this event, it is to be encouraged where possible.



FURTHER INFORMATION

ACCESS FOR THE EVENT:

- **Athletes** are to access the competition through the side entrance on the right of the Wales National Pool. Swansea Aquatics representatives will be there to greet them.
- **Non-athletes** are to access the competition through the front main entrance of the Wales National Pool. Officials, volunteers, coaches and team managers are to check in at the designated desk to collect poolside passes and club information packs.
- **Spectators** are to access the competition through the front main entrance of the Wales National Pool where they will check in at the spectator desk and collect pre-ordered spectator passes for the event. Spectator tickets **CANNOT** be purchased on arrival, tickets must be ordered in advance online.

Please show your ticket purchase receipt at the spectator desk upon arrival and you will be issued with a wrist band(s)

ATHLETE CHANGING VILLAGE:

The changing village is available for athletes. Misbehaviour within the changing village will not be tolerated.

REFRESHMENTS: The café within the Wales National Pool will be open.
