



Swansea Aquatics MAY LC OPEN Meet 2022

PLEASE ENSURE ALL ATTENDEES INCLUDING ATHLETES ARE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING

WITHDRAWALS FROM EVENT FINALS:

Withdrawals from finals including reserves must be made at the Withdrawal Desk (located under the scoreboard in the pool hall) within 10 minutes of the last heat completed in each session. A list of confirmed finalists will be available around 30 minutes after the closure of the withdrawal desk.

SIGN-IN (400M, 800M AND 1500M EVENTS):

The meet requires all swimmers to sign in for the 400m, 800m and 1500m events on arrival for each session of swimming. The Sign In desk is located under the scoreboard in the pool hall. Swimmers must SIGN IN before EACH session starts. Sign-in will close at the commencement of the first warm-up for the session. Swimmers who do not sign in will be scratched and will not be seeded in the heats.

EVENT PROTOCOLS

All persons attending the event must ensure compliance with any covid protocols and other guidance in place at the time of the event. The health, safety and well-being of all swimmers, officials, volunteers, spectators, and visitors is important - all Health and Safety regulations/requirements must be complied with at all times. It is the responsibility of the individuals attending to ensure that they have seen any such guidance.

Face Covering

From 28th February, it is not a legal requirement in Wales to wear a face covering in certain settings. Individuals are welcome to continue wearing face coverings if they need to or feel more comfortable in doing so and we encourage everyone to be respectful of this choice.

ACCESS FOR THE EVENT:

- **Athletes** arrive from 7.30am and access the competition through the main front entrance of the Wales National Pool.
- **Non-athletes** arrive from 7.30am and access the competition through the front main entrance of the Wales National Pool. Officials, volunteers, coaches, and team managers are to check in at the designated desk to collect poolside passes and club information packs.
- **Spectators** are to access the competition through the front main entrance of the Wales National Pool where they will check in at the spectator desk and collect pre-ordered spectator passes for the event.
